"Vegetarian" crocodile is no more

Babiya, the "spiritual" crocodile of Sri Anantha padmanabha swamy Temple in Majeshwaram taluk of Kasaragod district, is no more. On 9th October 2022 night the crocodile was found dead in the temple lake. Thousands off devotees crowd around the temple to pay honor while he was buried in temple premises on next day afternoon. The temple is surrounded by the lake and it is believed to be the Moolasthanam (Original Seat) of Shree Padmanabha Swamy in Thiruvananthapuram the crocodile was believed to have been

guarding a cave inside the lake into which Lord Vishnu is believed to have vanished. The chairman of the temple committee said that there were documents to prove that a crocodile named Babiya had lived in the lake and she was shot down by British officers in 1942. However within a few days, another crocodile had appeared and devotees named her Babiya. Since then temple priests had been protecting and offering "Nivedyam" to the crocodile. Temple Priest said that no one had ever seen Babiya eat fish or harm animals or humans. Babiya

was considered propitious by devotees who made offerings to her. The temple priests also offered her "Nivedyam" after morning and afternoon pujas every day and the crocodile use to come on the shore often without harming anyone to accept Nivedyam. According to temple authorities, Babiya was found to be unwell a few days ago. Veterinarians who conducted Post-mortem on next day said the crocodile had died due to age-related illness. The Veterinarians said that crocodile was around 80 years old.







Brahmastra Movie Review

For a generation raised on the notion that superheroes save the world - one Marvel and DC movie after another - Brahamstra is a welcome step out of Bollywood. Ayan Mukerji creates a spectacle so aesthetically pleasing that viewers simply push aside the shortcomings of the narrative to enjoy the 166 minutes of fine VFX, visually stunning scenes and beautiful music. It's a film with a very simple and pure message at its core and a comic booklike narrative on screen.

Before we get into the movie, you should understand what Brahmastra is all about. While the trailer is self-explanatory, here is a quick cheat sheet to understand the idea of Astraverse, India's first cinematic universe. Astraverse is essentially an ode to the supreme powers (jal, vaayu and agni) believed to be the reason for life's existence. All forces are harnessed in one way or another into the astras or weapons of light. Brahmastra is the story of the astras (borrowed from Hindu mythology) and the superheroes who control them and form the Brahmansh, in their entirety. The group, which prays to the supreme deity Brahm, aims to protect

But above them all is a force that puts things in perspective, that wins against all odds, and that is believed to win the battle every time - love.

The viewer goes through the story just like the main characters - the more secrets Isha finds out about Shiva, the more we know about him, and the more Shiva knows about what is happening in the universe, the more we understand it.

However, the story is not free of flaws and this is one of the weakest points of the film. The story has many potential elements, but what it focuses on makes the film a disappointing affair. At some points, the film feels simplistic and over-simplified - almost to the point of explaining to the viewer why a certain power does not work on the enemy, rather than letsecond half picks up the pace. The film, especially in the second half, delivers on its promise of bringing beautiful VFX to the screen. The stunt sequences, with all the forces at play, are among the film's finest moments. This is ambitious storytelling with technology and for that the team deserves a thumbs up.

Interestingly, the film falls during Dussehra and Diwali (the festival of light), which gives the makers ample opportunity to bring in all the beauty of love and light, and they do not disappoint! The film is also accompanied by some impressive music, and some of the pieces grow on

vou as the film progresses. The song in particular adds to the story and does not feel out of place.

Ranbir is spot on in the role of Shiva. The actor delivers a serious performance as he struggles to figure out the secrets of his past, the mysteries of his present, and the hopes for his future. He is the perfect embodiment of what superheroes stand for - rising against all odds. Alia Bhatt as Isha delivers another memorable performance. As Isha, she portrays her character with grace and is honest to her character arc. Together, Alia and Ranbir shine mostly because of their good chemistry. But the dialogues make some of their scenes exhausting and lead to inconsistent chemistry. And one might wonder how it starts with these two.

Amitabh Bachchan as Raghu Guru ji puts on a smart show (though one wishes there were more details about his character), while Nagarjuna Akkineni does well as Anish Shetty, who wields the Nandi Astra. Mouni Roy gets one of the more important roles as Junoon and she does it justice. Be on the lookout for a particularly sensational cameo appearance.



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

Heavy stones were used to build the pyramids, and it is said to weigh 6 million tones in all, compared to the present-day tallest structure, the Burj Khalifa, which weighs near 5,00,000 tones. The question that left people dumbstruck, How exactly was it built? Back then people didn't have cranes, bulldozers, or modern technology. So much so, they didn't even have wheels. Even so, they built a monument that still stands. There's no other surviving structure as old as this and as big as this. The more we go back in time, the more difficult it gets to figure out sure-shot what happened, when, and how. It is estimated that the Great Pyramid of Giza was built in the year 2560 BC, by the Pharaoh Khufu (The monarchs of ancient Egypt

The pyramid is located on the west bank of the River Nile, and if you see photos or videos of it, you'll see that it isn't the only pyramid. You do see two other pyramids built on the same site. Of the three, the tallest is the Pyramid of Giza, also known as the "Pyramid of Khufu". Smaller than it is the "Pyramid of Khafre", the second largest pyramid in Egypt. The third and the smallest is the "Pyramid of Menkaure". There are said to be a total of 118 pyramids of varying shapes and sizes. Many of them have been eroded by the extreme weathering and very few are in good con-

vast varieties of rocks that weigh anywhere between 2.5 tones to 80 tones. Each stone is carved so meticulously and evenly when there were no standards tools for carving. According to historians, about 20,000 to 30,000 workers were involved in its construction, working 10 hours in a day, to build this Great Pyramid of Giza.

the quarries. And once the stones were at the Pvramids, they were stacked on top of each other using sledges over wet ground. But the stacking of blocks on one another was not an easy task for them a system of pulleys can be used to lift them, as we know wheels didn't exist in Egypt during the 4th Dynasty. But they had built an efficient systhe same mechanism to draw water from the River Nile. To move the stone on the top they used wooden ramp a straight slope from the ground to the top, to move the stones up the slope. They installed a system of wooden pillars on the sides of the slopes, and then they used the ropes around the pillars, to pull up the stones. As far as the construction material is concerned, about 5.5 million tonnes of limestone, 8,000 tonnes of granite, and 5,00,000 tonnes of mortar were used. Most of these materials were sourced from the nearby areas. At most, they were brought in from the region of Southern Egypt that was around 800 km from the site. And then mortar was added to the layers on top that increases the stability of a structure. This is why throughout thousands of years the Pyramid of Giza still stands strong despite several earthquakes. The last step of the construction was the outermost layer of the pyramid which was made of fine, whit-

tem of ramps. They used ish limestone. It meant that when sunlight fell on it these pyramids would shine white brilliantly this was lost over thousands of years. Moving on from the construction to the design of the pyramids the pyramids are designed in a way that the directions point exactly towards North, East, South, and West. There was no compass back then. No modern technology such as GPS.

The Mystery of the Great Pyramid of Giza has so many conspiracy theories. Some people claim that the pyramids were built by aliens, because they believe it wasn't possible for humans to create this. This is the shortcut method of somehow coming up with an answer. It is better to acknowledge the facts that we know and then clearly lay out what we do not know, so that the next generation of archaeologists, historians can carry out research on them. This can help the historian and archeologists to discover the complete solution or explanation, about the mysteries.


SAFAR NAMA

Anand Agricultural University (AAU) is in the western Indian state of Gujarat between the cities of Vadodara and Ahmedabad and was established in 2004. It was formerly known as the Anand campus of the Gujarat Agricultural University but now is an independent body. It has three constituent colleges for Agriculture, Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry and Dairy Science.

It was established to provide educational support to the farming community in areas such as Agriculture, horticulture, engineering, information technology and business studies.

Anand Agricultural University was earlier a part of Gujarat Agricultural University, which was built on a benchmark started by Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel and KM Munshi in 1938 by incorporating Krishi-Go-Vidya Bhavan or Institute of Agriculture. The institute was known as Khetiwadi; later it became a part of Gujarat Agricultural University in 1972.

The BA College of Agriculture, established in 1947, was initially affiliated with the University of Bombay until 1956, followed by Gujarat University until 1962 and Sardar Patel University with the Sheth MC College of Dairy Science. In 1972 along with the Government College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, Anand became an integral institute of the Gujarat Agricultural University, which was established in 1964.

"Amul the Taste of India" is such a taste of our country that everyone is crazy about it. But this tasty journey was not the ordinary journey. This milk cooperative started with a movement which has its origin in Anand (family). It is a brand name which runs under the management of a cooperative society named Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation Limited. About 26 lakh milk products in Gujarat are owned by the Milk Marketing Federation Limited.

Major products of Amul are milk, milk powder, butter, ghee, paneer, curd, chocolate, shrine, skyward, ice cream, paneer, gulanjun, nutmaol etc. Amul (Anand Cooperative Milk Producers Union) was established on 14 December 1946. It started as a co-operative movement. During that time there was only one dairy in Gujarat, Polson Dairy, which was established in 1930. Jason was famous among the dairy elite. But at the same time, it also became famous for the protection of the farmers of the country.

National leader Shri Sardar Patel ji started non-negative towards it with some angry farmers. As a result, Amul India was established on 14 December 1946.

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel National Memorial is a memorial located in Ahmedabad as well as an exhibition centre. This monument is located in the area called Moti Shahi Mahal in Shahrukh, Ahmedabad, it was established on 7 March 1980.

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel National Memorial is one of the popular museums dedicated to the great Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. This palace was built in 1622 by the Mughal emperor Shah Jahan (1616-1622) to provide work to the poor during times of scarcity. The gardens of the palace of Shahi Bagh were very famous in the seventeenth century. It is a main attraction for the whole city.

The life and works of Mahatma Gandhi are displayed in a room attached to the Sardar Sarovar Hall. Many eminent personalities have spent their significant time in this palace. Chief among them was Rabindranath Tagore, the Bengali poet, writer and philosopher, who stayed at the palace in 1878 when he was only seventeen. It was here that he wrote his only ghost story, The Hungry Stones, and his first song.



Dr Kurien Home

Dr Kurien was born on 26 November 1921 in Calicut, Madras Presidency, British India (now Kozhikode, Kerala) into a Syrian Christian family. His father was a civil surgeon in Cochin, Kerala and he graduated in physics from Loyola College, Madras in 1940 and then mechanical engineering from Guindy, an engineering college affiliated with the University of Madras.

After completing his degree, he joined the Institute of Technical Steel, Jamshedpur in 1946. Thereafter, he joined Michigan State University in 1948 with the help of a scholarship given by the Government of India. and received a master's degree in mechanical engineering.

Dr Verghese Kurien was known as the 'Father of the White Revolution'. He is still famous for the world's largest agricultural development program 'Billion Litter Idea' (Operation Flood). This operation made India more developed than the US in 1998 and from a milk-deficient country to the largest producer of milk.

Dr Kurien has been appreciated for his work in India and abroad. For his contribution, the Government of India has also honoured him with 'Padma Vibhushan'.

Dr Verghese Kurien has depicted the struggles of his own life in letters. His famous books are "I Too Had a Dream", "The Man Who Made the Elephant Dance" (audiobook) and "An Unfinished Dream".









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
